- 1. **Credibility**: Standards are not clear, certifier and certified are not adequately separated, labels are not clear.
- 2. The **proliferation** of other certification schemes confuses consumers.
- 3. Certification can do **nothing to prevent** the most environmentally and socially destructive companies.

# 1. Credibility

The interpretation of FSC's Principles and Criteria is not consistent. For example, Criterion 6.3 should exclude the certification of monocultures:

"Ecological functions and values shall be maintained intact, enhanced, or restored, including: a) Forest regeneration and succession; b) Genetic, species, and ecosystem diversity; c) Natural cycles that affect the productivity of the forest ecosystem."


